- SAVE is an European I-NGO (International Non-Governmental Organization)
- SAVE was established in 1993 as an NGO-Network for the conservation of endangered breeds of domestic animals and cultivated plants
- SAVE is based in Konstanz/Germany
- SAVE is wide anchored: The Board of Directors consists of 15 directors out of 12 countries
- SAVE's monitoring across borders is done by "Monitoring Institute for Rare Breeds and Seeds"



What is SAVE doing?

- Mapping the former diversity (country by country, region by region)
- Watching the endangered breeds continuously (early warning mechanism)
- Rescuing and conserving, if there is a need for action (emergency response)
- Networking and Coordinating for a long term conservation by knowledge exchange and raising awareness





Why is SAVE active in the Carpathians?

- As in other mountain ranges a great diversity of plants and livestock breeds have developed and adapted to the specific conditions of different mountain areas (climate, exposition, topography,..)
- In remote valleys agriculture on performance is not easy. Some of the old breeds have survived and traditional agro-ecosystems still are active.
- These Traditional Agro-Ecosystems are not only of genetic and cultural interest, but are a chance for a different rural development with live quality!



- Establishment of nurseries for rare fruits and wild fruits in Moravia, Poland and Transcarpathia
- Creation of a unique synonym-register to facilitate crossborder cooperation





Establishment and Networking of Ark Stations

- Ark Stations are public accessible institutions showing rare breeds and/or endangered cultivated plants as Ark-farms, livestock parks, open-air museums and other institutions
- They play an important role by keeping core breeding groups of endangered livestock breeds and raising awareness for conservation. Some of them offer even special education facilities.
- The European Ark Network (<u>www.arca-net.info</u>) counts today 470 stations in 40 countries.



- Promote product marketing



Labelling for product promotion

- For a successful conservation of rare breeds the marketing of products has to be promoted
- The promotion may profit from the fact that most of the rare breeds deliver quality food.
- For the marketing of products of autochthonous breeds in general a new label is needed.
 SAVE is preparing such a label.
- The new label shall promote and protect <u>small</u> <u>scale</u>, <u>extensive production from local breeds</u>, using traditional processes in manufacturing and respecting animal welfare (as the organic label was before shifting to mass production with industrial breeds)


